As part of our Allied Health Team, the Occupational Therapist will be primarily based in the inpatient rehabilitation ward and day therapy clinic. It is expected that the Occupational Therapist undertakes functional assessments and re-training, equipment prescription, education and facilitation of groups, home assessments and simple modifications. Case load will include orthopaedic, amputee, neurological, frail elderly and rehabilitation after medical illness.

The Occupational Therapist also receives referrals from the Acute and oncology units. Referrals may include cognitive screening, pressure care assessments and safety assessments. Opportunity for the Occupational Therapist to provide education to the weekly joint clinics.

Opportunity for professional development is available to all hospital staff.
